Kandwal, Tehsil Baddi, Distt. Solan H.P.

Sir,

In continuation to this office letter No. PCB (M/s Baddi Infrastructure (21291)/  
13- 21956-62 dated 07-02-2013 vide which NOC / Consent to Establish in favour of M/s Baddi  
Infrastructure, BBN Industries Association, SWCA Building Baddi Barotiwala Raod Baddi  
Distt. Solan H.P. for setting up of a Common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) at Village  
Kandwal, Tehsil Baddi, Distt. Solan H.P.H.P. under Water Act, 1974/Air Act, 1981 was  
issued. As per on line report of the Sr. Environmental Engineer, H.P. State Pollution Control  
Board Baddi, Distt. Solan H.P, the plan and design of the infrastructure is as per approval and  
construction as per norms and as such final no objection certificate / consent to operate is  
issued under Water Act, 1974/Air Act, 1981 subject to the compliance of terms and conditions  
already imposed in the original consent letter. In addition to the following conditions: -

1. This Consent to Operate is valid up to 31-3-2016 subject to concurrent validity of the Authorization under Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2008 or any other authorization required from the State Board.
2. Proponent shall install real-time online monitoring equipment, data connectivity with the HP State Pollution Control Board and Central Pollution Control Board servers by 30-06-2015 and submit a bank guarantee equivalent to 100% of the cost of the equipment to the HP State Pollution Control Board as per direction of Central Pollution Control Board.
3. Proponent shall prepare and submit a comprehensive plan for utilization of the treated water from common effluent treatment plant within a month.
4. This consent to operate is only for the purpose and under the provisions of the Water(Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act,1974 and Air(Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1981 as the case may be, and will not construed as substitute for mandatory clearances required for the project under any other law/regulation/direction/order and the applicant shall obtain any such mandatory clearances before taking any steps to establish industry/industrial plant, operation or process or any treatment and disposal system or an extension or addition thereto.
5. This consent to operate is for:
  - (i) Noise/Emission from DG set conforms to limits prescribed in Sr. No. 94 & 95 of Schedule-I of Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
  - (ii) Noise & ambient air quality to be maintained within Ambient air Quality Standards for noise as specified in Schedule-III of aforesaid Rules and Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules, 2000 as well as those CPCB.

- (iii) The Industrial effluents, 25 MLD to be treated in common effluent treatment plant as provided by the proponent. The treatment shall conforming to the norms as prescribed in Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 as amended from time to time.
6. Pollution Control Devices provided by the unit shall be operated and maintained to meet the norms for emissions/effluent and noise.
  7. The Project proponent shall be liable to clear any past/current liability on account of difference of consent fees including penalties if detected at any subsequent stage.
  8. The emission/effluent (whichever may be applicable) shall be got sampled and tested by the unit/concerned regional officer and further renewal shall be dependant up on the results of samples so conducted.
  9. Project proponent shall not undertake the expansion activity/ or additional in the existing unit without obtaining the prior permission from the State Board.
  10. The State Board reserves the right to revoke/review and alter the conditions of consent to operate as the case may be.
  11. The project proponent shall comply with the provisions of the e-waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2011, as may be, applicable to it.
  12. This consent is subject to the ratification by the Board.
- Unit shall have to apply for renewal of consent for next years before 31-03-2016.
