

Matter of R-factor for assessment of Treatment Charges

The matter of R-factor for assessment of treatment charges has been under the consideration of the Board of Baddi Infrastructure. In this regard the matter was discussed and deliberated by a Committee constituted by the Board with you in the meeting held on 30-03-2017. On the basis of mutual consensus & agreement arrived at during the meeting of 30-03-2017, the matter was placed before the Board of Directors of Baddi Infrastructure in the 45th Meeting held on 21-04-2017 and the following has been approved by the Board:

1. R-factor equivalent to 23% as mutually negotiated by the Committee with UPLEEL was approved from 1st April, 2017 up to 31-03-2018 in place of 18% ad hoc value allowed at present.
2. After 31-03-2018, the R-factor shall be determined in April every year by determining the weighted variation in Wholesale Price Index (WPI) [Source: Office of Economic Adviser, Govt. of India, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion] & Consumer Price Index (CPI) [Source: Labour Bureau, Government of India] in the preceding twelve months by assigning weightage of 75% to WPI and 25% to CPI respectively.
3. In the matter of giving discounts in treatment charges to the single unit or multiple units of the same promoter group which give effluent quantity in large quantities, the following discounts were approved by the Board to be granted with effect from May, 2018:

Sr. No.	Volume of effluent given by an industry	Quantity of discount permissible in treatment charges
1	More than three million litres per day	3%
2	More than six million litres per day	7%

Note: Discount would be permissible to those single unit or multiple units of the same promoter group whose average quantity during a month was according to the above threshold quantities of effluent.
